



Government of India entrusts research project to Dr Arijit Das

Agartala, Dec 10, 2013 : In an emphatic recognition of his talent and proven capacity for innovation, the government of India has entrusted Tripura's brilliant chemistry professor Dr Arijit Das (36) with responsibility for an important two year project at a cost of Rs 12 lakhs . The project has been awarded by senior scientist Amitava Roy of Scientific and Engineering Resaearch Board (SERB), an appendage of the union ministry of science and technology, in an official communication on December 4 this year.

Dr Arijit Das has already earned kudos at the national and international level from stalwarts of chemistry as also from world-famous institutions such as American Chemical Society (ACS) by devising 13 new methodologies and 28 new formulae for easier study of Organic , Inorganic and Physical chemistry . "The project requires me to do 'synthetic inorganic analysis with biological and luminescent property' ; I will need a junior research fellow to assist me in the work and I have already advertised for one; completing the project within the stipulated time will not be a problem" said Dr Arijit Das. He added that he was now busy with preparatory work and actual work on the project would begin in full swing from January next year.
